SUBJECT: PINAL COUNTY ATTORNEY APPROVAL TO ACCEPT THE NATIONAL CHILDREN'S ALLIANCE (NCA) DTVF 2021 TRAINING GRANT

Discussion/approval/disapproval The Pinal County Attorney's Office requests approval to accept the National Children's Alliance (NCA) Expanding Access to Children's Advocacy Centers' Resources and Services for Victims of Child Pornography and Human Trafficking (DTVF) award # FLOR-AZ-TDTVF21 between the National Children's Alliance (NCA), and the Pinal County Attorney's Office, through the Pinal County Board of Supervisors, for a total of \$21,533.75 to commence January 1, 2021 and terminate December 31, 2021. The award will be used to provide training in child pornography and trafficking to the County Attorney's San Tan Valley Family Advocacy Center.

Acceptance requires an amendment to the FY 20/21 budget to transfer reserve appropriation from Fund 213 (Grants/Project Contingency) to Fund 268 (CO Atty Misc Grants) to increase revenue and expenditure appropriations. There is no impact on the General Fund.
