



Grant Agreement

This Grant Agreement ("Grant Agreement") is entered into between PetSmart Charities Inc., an Arizona nonprofit corporation and tax-exempt public charity under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code ("Code"), whose address is 19601 N. 27th Avenue, Phoenix, AZ 85027 ("Charities"), and **Pinal County Animal Care and Control** whose address is 1150 S Eleven Mile Corner Rd., Casa Grande AZ 85122 United States, ("Grantee").

Grant Purpose and Terms:

Grant Funds	\$15,000
Grant Purpose	<p>The Grant funds in the amount of \$15,000 over 18 months. Funds will be used by the Organization to support Pinal County Animal Care and Control's Project Pet Care program, providing access to veterinary care for owned animals in Pinal County. Veterinary services such as spay/neuter, wellness/preventative medicine and basic veterinary care such as but not limited to eye/ear/skin infection and wound care will be provided to owned pets at a low-cost or subsidized rate.</p> <p>The intent of the grant is to provide subsidized veterinary care to approximately 150 owned pets through the provision of veterinary services.</p> <p>Grant funds may be used for but are not limited to: Veterinary exams and supplies, spay/neuter, vaccines, wellness and preventative supplies, dental care/surgery, minor medical/surgical treatments, program related capital expenses and staffing.</p>
Distribution Schedule of Grant Funds	Cash in single installment of \$15,000
Grant Period	Upon execution through June 24, 2022.
Grant Conditions	<p>If the Organization wishes to request an extension, a request must be submitted in writing to PetSmart Charities at CharitiesCompliance@PetSmart.com a minimum of 30 days prior to grant end date. The request must outline progress to date including funds expended, funds remaining and a rationale for the requested grant amendment or extension.</p> <p>If any grant funds remain unspent for the purpose and term of this grant, the Organization must contact PetSmart Charities within 30 days after the end of the grant term for consideration of remaining funds or return any unused funds to PetSmart Charities.</p>
