








Epi Curve week 53 total cases



community


Epi curve comparative community cases and correctional (inmates) cases

COVID VACCINE UPDATE

The initial allocation of 10,000 doses of Moderna COVID Vaccine for Pinal, were disseminated between public health and 14 other community partners

5,700 doses were direct ship to internal, closed pods for healthcare professionals and 1b healthcare support staff, along with correctional officers and support staff

Of the remaining 4,300 doses 4,100 have been administered, or are scheduled to be administered.

Of the 200 remaining doses, the community partners have begun administering

* First allocation was received throughout the week of December 21st to December 24th
