



Budget Highlights FY22

Infrastructure

- Hundreds of millions in new transportation funding. These projects support infrastructure across Arizona. Here are a few highlights:
 - \$50M dollars to widen the I-10 between Phoenix and Casa Grande
 - \$90M in pavement rehabilitation and preservation for non-Maricopa and Pima highways
 - \$18M deposit in the State Aviation Fund to support airports. This brings down a 9-to-1 federal match meaning our \$18M investment brings down \$162M in federal dollars.
 - Over \$122M in dollars to improve Arizona's state highways. This includes:
 - ❖ Repaving parts of SR 69 in Prescott Valley.
 - ❖ Improving US 95 near the Yuma Proving Ground.
 - ❖ Repaving major parts of SR 95 in Bullhead City, Lake Havasu City, and Mohave Valley.
 - ❖ Repaving SR 77 in Oro Valley.
 - ❖ Repairs to SR 186 in Willcox.
 - ❖ Repaving SR 90 near Fort Huachuca.
 - \$35M to construct a new overpass on SR 347, which will improve the safety and speed of travel for those traveling between the Phoenix Metro and the City of Maricopa.
 - \$4M to help fund a study of a new north-south corridor in Pinal County.
 - \$27M to support local infrastructure projects across Arizona including:
 - ❖ 67th Ave drainage improvement, which includes a \$24M in local matching funds.
 - ❖ Ocotillo Bridge in Gilbert, which includes a \$54.5M in local matching funds.
 - ❖ Camelback Road between SR303 & Litchfield Road
