- Cost statement, which must show and compare actual expenditures to expenditures projected in the budget submitted with Grantee's proposal, using the attached ledger (under Small Grants Tab)
- Explanation for differences between projected and actual Line Item expenditure amounts.
- Digital photos or other electronic media examples of results.

Additionally, please provide or be ready and able to show to ADVS all original written receipts or other written and verifiable proofs of grant money expenditures that are acceptable to ADVS.

Please note, any and all VDF Grant money awarded that is not expended for the event, program, or project purpose must be returned to ADVS

Please send your replies to the attention of the VDF Grant Program at the address listed below, or via email to vdf@azdvs.gov. Failure to provide this information may result in the denial of future grant proposals.
