**RE: Electrical District No. 4 (ED4) Request to Cancel Annual Election – Saturday, January 14, 2023.**


Dear Elections Director,

Notice is hereby given to all qualified electors of the above District that an election to fill the vacancy on the Board of Directors created by the expiration of the term(s) of: Mark Hamilton and Daniel F. Shedd, will be held on the 14th day of January 2023 at the following polling place between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.

It is not necessary to register to vote in this election, however, in order to vote, a qualified elector must own real property located within the District, which is, or may be, beneficially serviced by the District. The acreage system of voting will be in effect for the election meaning that a person, in order to vote, must be 18 years of age or older and have owned real property, or be the designated representative of an entity which has owned real property, in the District's taxable boundaries for over 90 days prior to the election which real property is or may be beneficially served by the District. Such individual will be entitled to one vote for each acre owned of said real property.

Persons desiring to become candidates for the position may obtain Nomination Petitions and Nomination Papers from:


