**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PINAL COUNTY
APPROVING THE FEE SCHEUDLE FOR ETHE PINAL COUNTY AQUIFER
PROTECTION DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, the Pinal County Board of Supervisors has the authority, pursuant to A.R.S. 11-251.08 to establish fees for products and services provided by the County; and

WHEREAS, Pinal County is required to issue permits for Environmental Health pursuant to regulations adopted by the Pinal County Board of Supervisors by Resolution dated October 5, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the fee amounts attached to this Resolution only defray or cover the expense incurred by the County for the issuance of permits and do not exceed the actual costs for issuance of said permits; and

WHEREAS, on March 28, 2001, The Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 32801-EHF, which established certain fees and that Fee Schedule is in need of revision to meet the change in costs for services; and

WHEREAS, this matter has been reviewed by the Pinal County Board of Supervisors on June 7, 2023 in a Work Session and a Public Hearing was held before the Pinal County Board of Supervisors on November 1, 2023, to take public testimony regarding the proposed fee schedule.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the County of Pinal as follows:

SECTION 1: The following fee schedule is hereby adopted as the Pinal County Aquifer Protection Fee Schedule:
