# State of Az Mutual Aid Compact



## What is the State of Arizona Mutual Aid Compact (AZMAC)?

- The AZMAC enables participating political subdivisions and tribal nations to share resources, materials, personnel, etc. during emergencies and then be reimbursed for the resource, personnel and/or material.

# State of Az Mutual Aid Compact



## What are the benefits to the AZMAC?

- Mutual aid agreements provide a mechanism to participating parties to quickly obtain emergency assistance in the form of personnel, equipment, materials, and other related services.
- The primary objective is to facilitate rapid, short-term deployment of emergency support prior to, during and after an incident.
- A signed agreement does not obligate the provision or receipt of aid, the Compact provides a tool for use should the incident dictate a need.

# State of Az Mutual Aid Compact



## Who can participate in the AZMAC?

- All state agencies;
- Any political subdivision;
- Counties;
- Incorporated cities and towns;
- School districts;
- Community college districts;
- Other tax levying public districts in the State of Arizona;
- Federally recognized tribal nations ;

# State of Az Mutual Aid Compact



## What is the duration of the AZMAC?

- Upon the mutual consent of the parties concerned, the Compact remains in effect for 10 years, to December 31st, 2033, or until participation is terminated by the Party.
- The current AZMAC expires on December 31, 2023.
