WHEREAS the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in and for Pinal County is the chief judicial officer of the county and has administrative authority over all the courts in Pinal County, pursuant to Article VI of the Arizona Constitution and Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 2017-79; and,

WHEREAS the Pinal County Justice Courts have requested the following appointment of Michelle O’Hair Schattenburg, John Ore, Angel Raymond, John Assini and Becky Assini; sponsored by the Honorable Shaun Babeu JP1 and the Honorable Ellie Brown JP5.

WHEREAS the Presiding Judge finds that the afore-listed request for appointment is necessary, appropriate and in the best interest of the Judicial Branch of Government in Pinal County;

NOW, THEREFORE pursuant to A.R.S. § 22-121(B),

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the following are hereby appointed to serve as Justice of the Peace *Pro Tempore*, for a period commencing November 15, 2023 and ending December 31, 2023.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, appointing the above Justice of the Peace *Pro Tempore* to serve as Juvenile Hearing Officers to process, adjudicate and dispose of all cases in which a child under the age of 18 years on the date of the alleged offense is charged with violating any of the laws as set forth in A.R.S. §8-323(B), with the exception of the driving under the influence and civil violations involving the possession and personal use of marijuana, marijuana products or paraphernalia, unless specifically approved by the Presiding Juvenile Court Judge on a case by case basis.

Within five days after disposition, the Juvenile Hearing Officer shall transmit a copy of the citation and the findings and disposition of the court noted on the copy, as set forth in A.R.S §8-323(H) and the Pinal County Justice/Municipal Courts Policy and Procedure, dated June 7, 2014, and titled “Reporting Juvenile Case Information to Juvenile Court Services.”

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **Justice of the Peace *Pro Tempores***’ be compensated in accordance with state law, payable through funds budgeted in the Judicial Branch and/or the Justices of the Peace for such purposes; and,

This appointment is at the pleasure and direction of the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court. Such appointment may be terminated without cause at any time by the Presiding Judge.
