1. Briefly describe your organization's history, mission and goals.

History: Formed in 1875, Pinal County Sheriff's Office (PCSO) is the 3rd largest sheriff's office in Arizona. Pinal County Sheriff's Office provides patrol services, criminal investigations, search & rescue, and operates the County Detention Center. There are approximately 500 employees with nearly 230 patrol Deputies sworn.

The Pinal County Sheriff's Office also overlaps Districts 1-4 of the Gila River Indian Community.

Mission: To Preserve the Peace, Protect Life and Property, and promote Public Safety while upholding the Constitution. Goals: To proudly serve Pinal County's diverse community with enthusiasm.

3. Describe the proposed project, objectives, and your plan to implement.

This project will expand the Pinal County Regional DUI Task Force deployment areas and allow for overall improvement of operations. The Pinal County Sheriff's Office Traffic Unit manages and schedules DUI Task Force deployments throughout the year each month, during Holiday weekends that includes three enforcement nights, and weekends from Thanksgiving through New Year's Eve.

Currently when the DUI Task Force deploys, we utilize the Pinal County Regional DUI Task Force Command Post. This is an RV type motorhome that is operational, functional, and recently refurbished on the interior to include replacing components such as cosmetics, A/C and heating units, inverters, lighting, roof sealing, and generator tune up. However, this command post is a 2008 model that has endured expected mechanical problems in which repairs are necessary to remain deployable and operational. Some of these repairs and



motor maintenance issues are costly and take time in the shop, which occasionally happens during our task force deployments. In those cases, the DUI Command Post is unavailable and Deputies and Officers working the task force have to utilize nearest substations for processing.

During times when the DUI Command Post is down for maintenance or repairs, the DUI Van requested would serve in it's place. This would allow DUI processing of two subject's at a time. Additionally, when the DUI Command Post is operational and deployed, this DUI Van would be deployed simultaneously in a different area in Pinal County, which consists of nearly 5,400 square miles. The Pinal County Regional DUI Task Force deploys in areas including: Apache Junction, San Tan Valley, Coolidge, Casa Grande, and Maricopa. In times when the DUI Command Post is deployed to Casa Grande, the DUI Van would simultaneously be deployed nearby in Arizona City, or Eloy. Or, when the DUI Command Post is deployed to San Tan Valley, the DUI Van would simultaneously be deployed nearby in Florence or Coolidge, or Apache Junction. During major Holidays such as New Year's Eve, the Pinal County Regional DUI Task Force deploys in Casa Grande and San Tan Valley. In this case, we would utilize two command posts in those regions. Additionally, the DUI Van can be readily available to respond to specific locations around Pinal County that require on the spot DUI processing and paperwork completion. This would be for major incidences such as vehicle crimes, or Homicide investigations that may require a blood draw station.

The objective of this grant request to procure a DUI Van will drastically improve overall operations for not only the Pinal County Sheriff's Office, but for our other law enforcement agencies that make up the Regional DUI Task Force; to include: Apache Junction, Superior, Mammoth, Florence, Coolidge, Queen Creek, Casa Grande, Eloy, Gila River, Maricopa, and Arizona DPS. Agencies that participate in any DUI deployment managed by the Pinal County Sheriff's Office has full access to the DUI Command Post and will have full access to the DUI Van for DUI processing.

4. Describe how the proposed project satisfies one or more of the priority funding areas identified by the Gila River Indian Community.

The Pinal County Sheriff's Office Traffic Unit is comprised of 8 Deputies, 2 Sergeants, and 1 Lieutenant. The goal of the Pinal County Sheriff's Office Traffic Unit is to promote public safety of the roadways in Pinal County through enforcement, engineering, and education. Deputies in the Traffic Unit go through extensive specialty training in order to conduct full and thorough traffic related investigations. Traffic Deputies



specialize in speed enforcement, DUI enforcement, commercial vehicle enforcement and inspections, investigating vehicular fatalities, phlebotomy, homicide investigations, and enforcement on law enforcement motorcycles.

This project prioritizes public safety and provides high visibility to our citizens and commuters. The Pinal County Regional DUI Task Force command post vehicles are deployed and set up at high traffic volume areas, along major roadways within our cities and towns. Being visible along our roadways is a constant reminder to the public that we are enforcing traffic laws, identifying and removing impaired drivers, and making our roadways safer for all.

5. Identify the needs/problems to be addressed, target population and number of people to be served by the project.

As of 2023 the population of Pinal County is approximately 496,174. Pinal County is home to one of the biggest bedroom communities in the State of Arizona, San Tan Valley, which is unincorporated and relies on the Pinal County Sheriff's Office for law enforcement needs. The Pinal County Regional DUI Task Force provides supplemental Traffic and DUI Enforcement during the monthly deployments. This includes Casa Grande, Apache Junction, Maricopa, Coolidge, Eloy, and Florence. Pinal County Sheriff's Office Deputies and Traffic Deputies identify and remove impaired drivers every day on our roadways. We serve not only citizens who reside in Pinal County, but also those who commute on our Pinal County roadways every day.

6. Define the project as a new or continuing program. Has GRIC previously funded this project?

The project to procure a DUI Processing Van is a new program area as we prepare for the future, to include replacing the aging 2008 DUI RV Command Post when it becomes no longer fully operational. Other agencies have transitioned to the smaller more mobile command vehicles for DUI Processing during DUI Task Force Deployments. The GRIC has not previously funded nor reviewed this project.



7. Provide a brief timeline including start and finish dates. Indicate if the timeline is flexible.

The timeline is flexible. Upon approval of this award, and accepted by the Pinal County Board of Supervisors, a request will be submitted for a purchase order to secure an available 2024 Ford Transit High Roof Van. This will take place during the 4th Quarter of 2024 calendar year. The van would then be built and upfitted to provide two work stations and blood draw stations for DUI investigations, along with the installation of emergency lights and scene lights. Once the upfitting is completed, The DUI Van will be ready for deployments as it would be fully operational. This project should be finished with a completed DUI Van during the 1st Quarter of 2025.

8. Identify other organizations, partners or funders participating in the project and their roles.

There are no other partners or funders participating in this project. The Gila River Indian Community would be the sole provider and only funder of this project.

9. Would you be able to implement the proposed plan if your organization received partial funding for this project?

No. Funding for a DUI Van and to replace the aging Pinal County Regional DUI Task Force RV Command Post is not part of fiscal year budgeting at this time.

10. Describe your plan for project financial sustainability beyond the grant period. If this is a program/project previously funded by the Gila River Indian Community describe efforts made towards the previously described sustainability plan.

The Pinal County Sheriff's Office will continue to maintain the grant provided vehicle and equipment to ensure preventative maintenance is maintained, and repairs are completed as necessary so this asset is sustained for several years. With vehicle warranty, workmanship warranty, and care, this DUI Van will remain operational for the foreseeable future.

11. Describe your plan to document progress and results.

Each and every time the Pinal County Regional DUI Task Force deploys around Pinal County for saturated DUI Enforcement, statistics of deployment success are reported and tallied. Traffic Deputies also submit bi weekly stat sheets at the end of every two week pay period to document their proactivity and workload.

These statistics are maintained by the traffic supervisor and up to date immediately following a detail.

Additionally, PCSO maintains a sign in sheet that includes other agenices names and information for when they participate in our DUI Task Force deployments. Other reports will be submitted back to the GRIC near the end of the grant cycle to report progress and results.


