**ADDENDUM FUNDING AGREEMENT FOR THE FOLLOWING (as applicable):**  
**JUVENILE MONETARY SANCTIONS FUNDING BACKFILL APPROPRIATION**

---

**Fiscal Year 2024**

The Arizona Supreme Court, Administrative Office of the Courts, ("AOC"), and the **SUPERIOR COURT in Pinal COUNTY** ("Grantee") agree to add this Addendum to the Fiscal Year 2024 Funding Agreement to acquire additional monies to implement the Juvenile Monetary Sanctions Funding Backfill Appropriation which became effective **July 1, 2023**.

- a. **The budget** includes a one-time increase of \$250,000 from the General Fund in FY 2024 for juvenile monetary sanctions backfill funding. The 3-year spending plan continues this one-time appropriation in FY 2025 and FY 2026 and is subject to Legislative approval/funding for each subsequent fiscal year.
- b. **Monies in** this line item provide backfill funding to replenish revenues lost from the repeal of juvenile monetary sanctions. Laws 2023, Chapter 162 repeals certain court-ordered fees for juveniles, exempts juveniles from court surcharges and assessments, and prohibits courts from charging a juvenile or the juvenile's parent or guardian for the costs of court-ordered treatment, counseling, and other services.
- c. **The AOC** will disseminate a percentage of this amount to each juvenile probation department statewide as part of this funding agreement. The allocation for each county will be based on an average annual percentage of what each county collected in relation to the other fourteen counties between FY20-FY22.
- d. **Monies** allocated to each county is non-reverting and can be spent however deemed appropriate to replenish revenues lost from the repeal of juvenile monetary sanctions.
- e. **Each** county juvenile probation department will determine which account the monies will be placed.
