RESOLUTION OF THE PINAL COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS DETERMINING THE VALIDITY OF PETITIONS SUBMITTED FOR A BOUNDARY CHANGE FOR THE QUEEN CREEK COUNTY ISLAND FIRE DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, petitioners have requested a change to the boundaries of the Queen Creek County Island Fire District; and

WHEREAS, Arizona Revised Statute (A.R.S.) § 48-262A(12) requires that the Board of Supervisors determine the validity of the petitions submitted; and

WHEREAS, the Pinal County Assessors Office has conducted a review of the petitions based upon A.R.S. §§ 48-262 and 48-266 and the Assessor's records. The Assessor's report is attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, based upon the records of the Assessor in order to meet the requirements of A.R.S. § 48-262 the petitions would have to contain 117 valid property owner signatures and the petitions reviewed only contained 112 valid property owner signatures; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Pinal County Board of Supervisors determines, pursuant to A.R.S. § 48-262A(12) that the petitions submitted do not meet the requirements of A.R.S. § 48-262A(10)(b) and are therefore not valid to order the boundary change requested;
