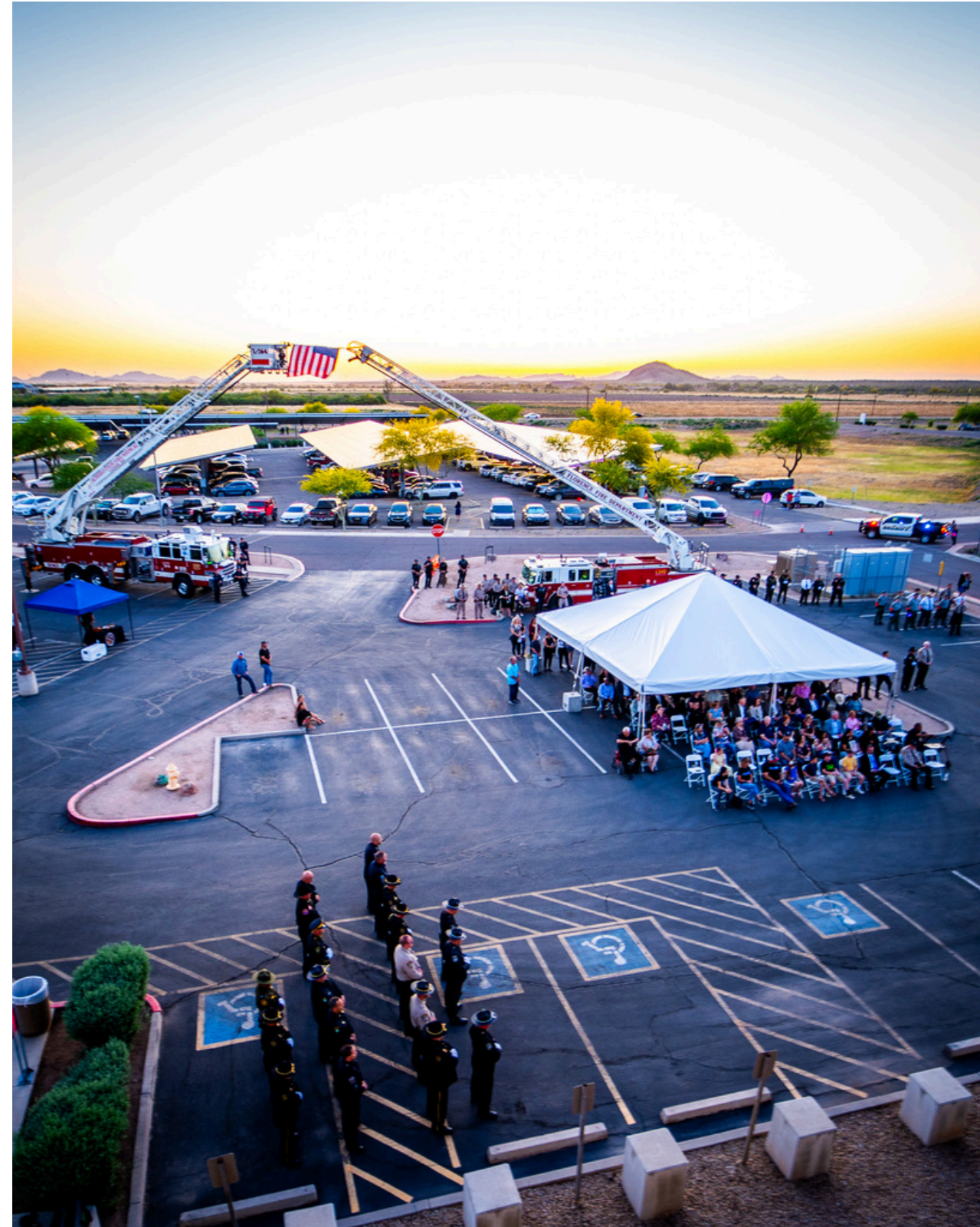

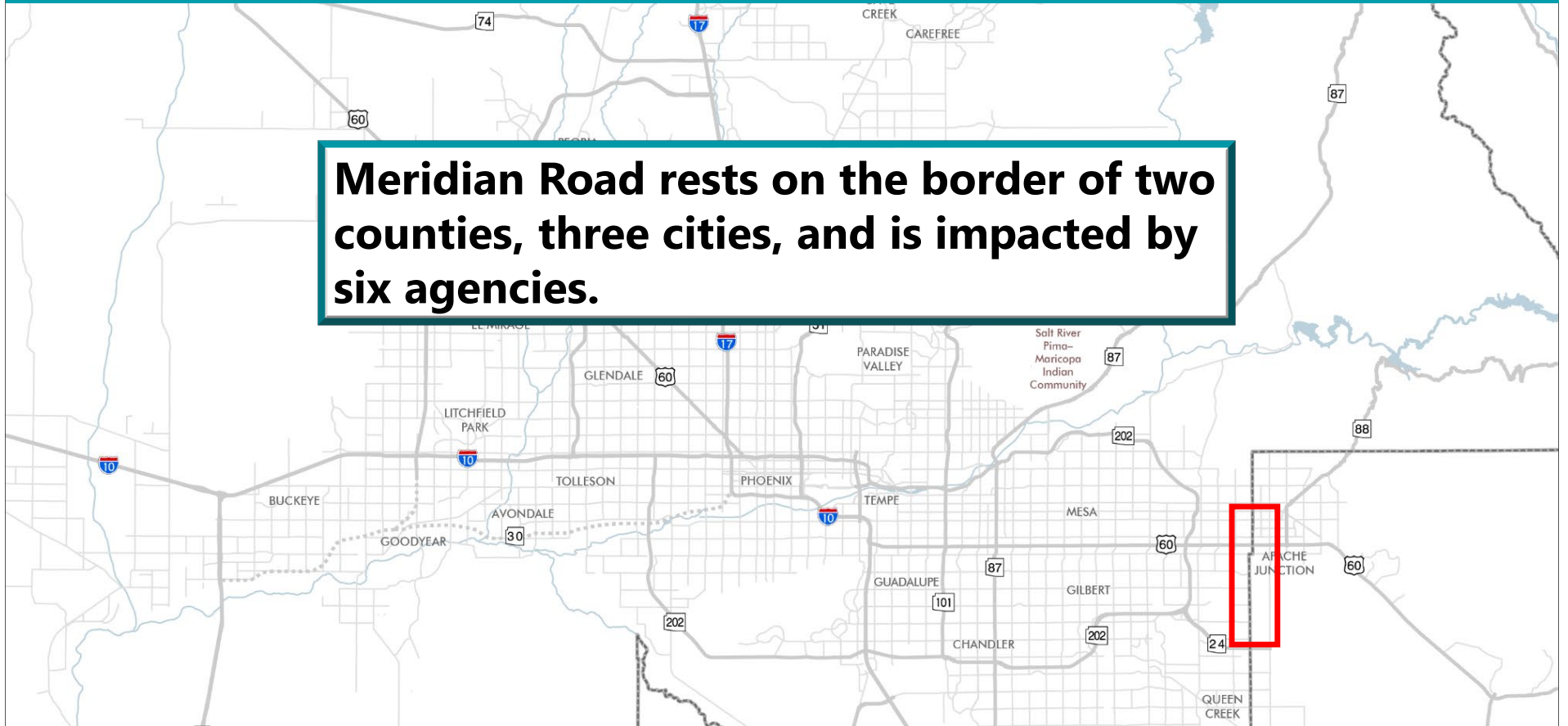

Identify alignment options, roadway facility type, lane configurations, and ultimate ROW requirements



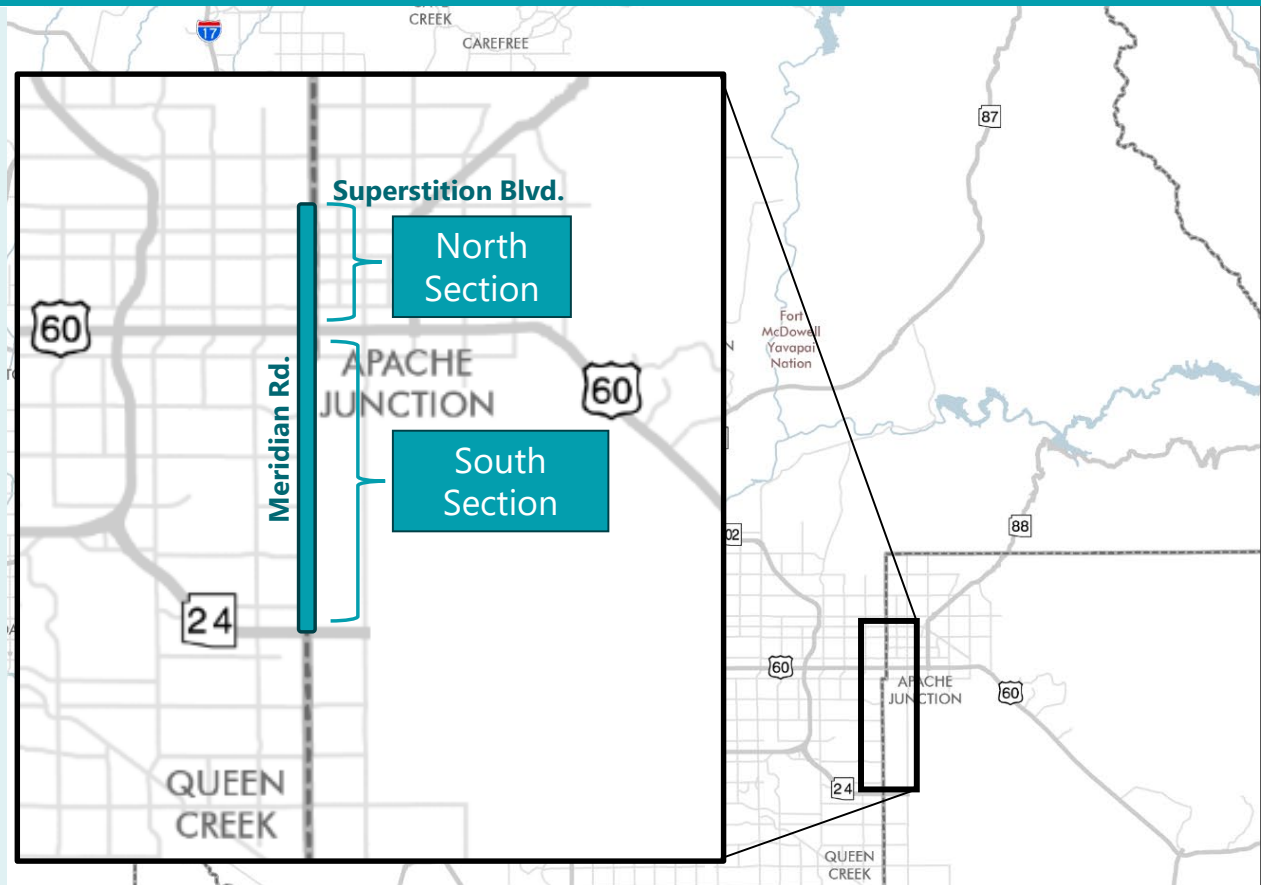

Summer 2024



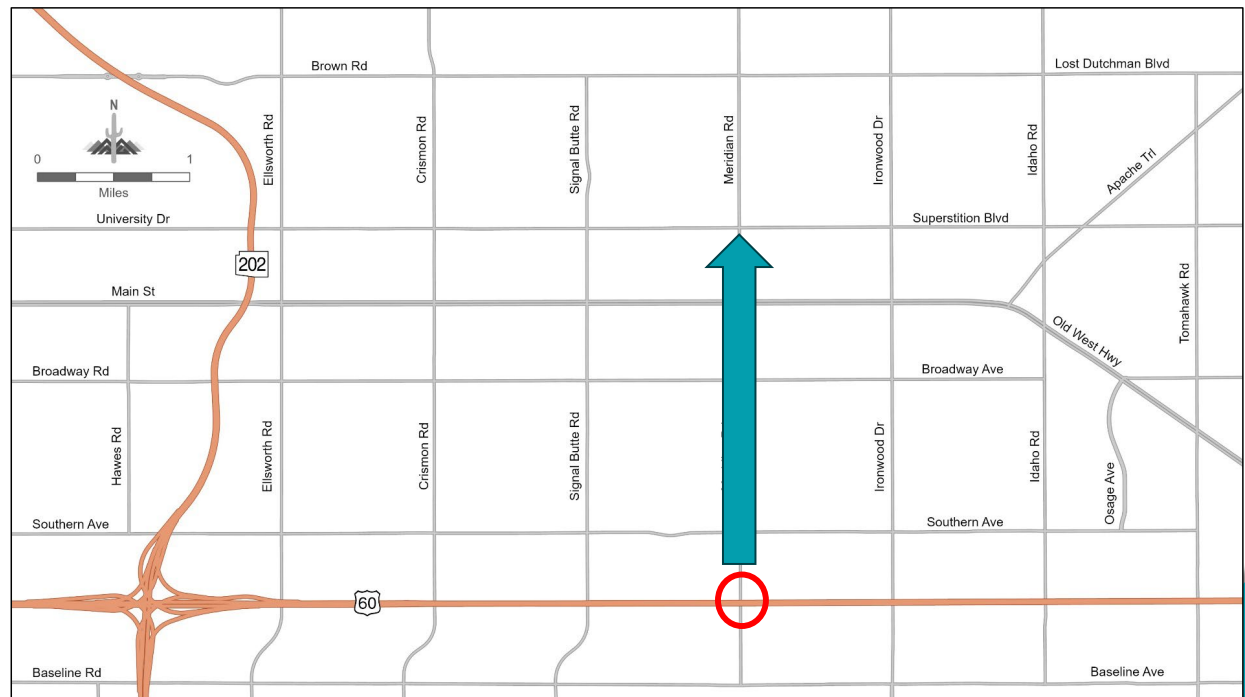

The focus on the section of Meridian Road will include:

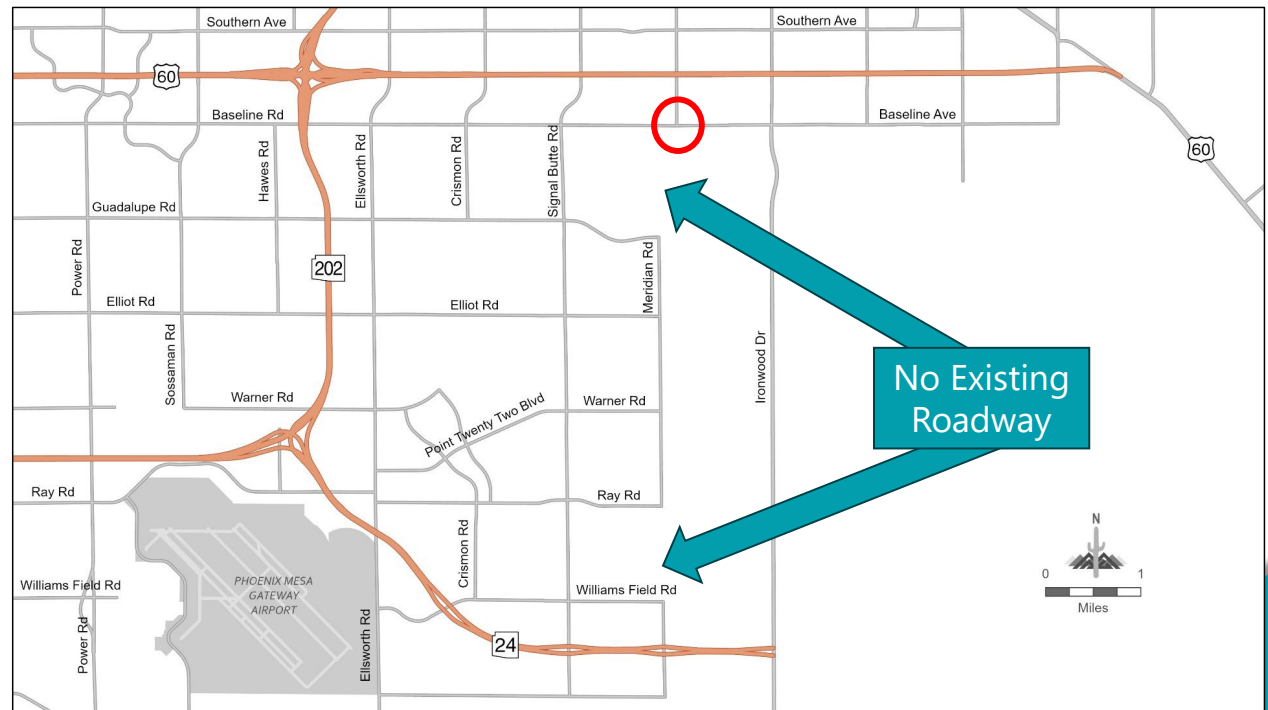
- ▶ Roadway widening

- ▶ US 60/Meridian Road Interchange improvements

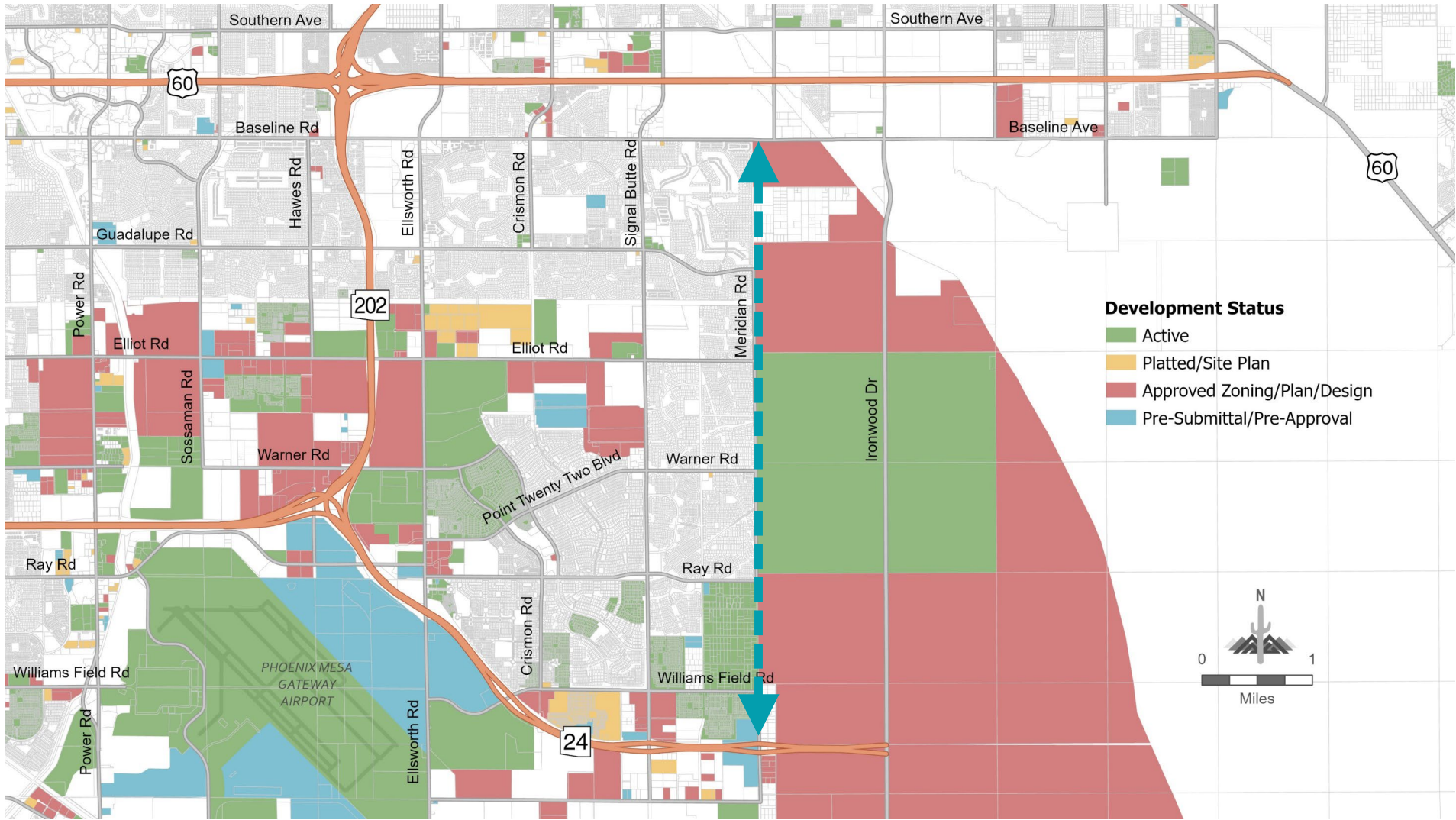


# South Section Meridian: US 60 to SR 24
