RESOLUTION OF THE PINAL COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF REAL PROPERTY TO THE TOWN OF KEARNY FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Pinal County owns real property within the Town of Kearny ("Kearny") known as Kelly Haddad Administration Building ("Property"); and

WHEREAS, Kearny has been using the majority of the Property under lease from the County since July 1, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the County's use of the Property has been limited to Public Health , and other uses as determined to benefit the County; and

WHEREAS, Kearny has identified potential uses of the Property which will enhance assist in the creation and retention of jobs in the Kearny area and otherwise enhance the economic welfare of its residents; and

WHEREAS, the County still uses a portion of the Property to service its WIC Program and Kearny has expressed its willingness to allow that use to continue through a lease of a portion of the Property back to the County; and

WHEREAS, the County is authorized by A.R.S. § 11-254.04 to appropriate and spend monies in connection with economic development activities including the conveyance of real property;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Pinal County shall transfer the Property known as the Kelly Haddad Administrative Building to the Town of Kearny by Quit Claim Deed attached hereto as Exhibit A, subject to Kearny's agreement to lease a portion of the Property back to Pinal County upon terms acceptable to the County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Board is authorized to execute and deliver the deed attached hereto as Exhibit A to the Town of Kearny.
