- Senate 733 / House 944 / HCRs/SCRs 124
- Feb 21st deadline for bills to be heard in chamber of origin\*
   \*Appropriations receives an extra week
- Anything not heard considered dead
- Unless it comes back as a "striker" or strike everything amendment in committee of origin

  - HB 2006 Election mailings "Not from a gov't agency"
  - HB 2007 Payment Prohibited for Voter Reg Forms
  - HB 2008 Notary Public Reqs
  - SCR 1027 Foreign Money in Elections
