Narrative for Peralta Trails Elementary School Community Pickleball Court Surfacing Project

A. Purpose of Grant.

- 1. Provide standard pickleball courts for Gold Canyon community at Peralta Trail Elementary school in order to support student physical education and community participation of this increasingly popular pickleball sport which brings communities and generations together for fun and recreation while providing for healthy physical and mental activity for overall well-being of our community. The impacted amenities while owned by the Apache Junction Unified School district, are available for the broader Gold Canyon Community to enjoy. These facilities are heavily used by the community even in their current rudimentary state which is a plain cement slab with no standard surfacing. There has been high demand for these significant improvements which not only will support the rapid growth of the sport but will also provide a safer surface for players with less risk of slipping and lower body impact reducing strain and injury risk for players. This project will be accomplished through the following actions:
 - a) Provide services and supplies to prepare existing cement surface by repairing and patching existing cracks and imperfections.
 - b) Provide materials and services to apply acrylic surfacing and paint court lines to provide standard pickleball court surfacing.
 - c) Purchase and installing nets on courts.
 - d) Purchase and install rocks and rock binder on surrounding perimeter surface in order to minimize rocks and debris from coming onto court and damaging surface coating.
- 2. The target population for the project are the students at Peralta Trails Elementary School and the residents of the Gold Canyon Community which represents a growing population of approximately 12,500 residents. There are currently no public standard pickleball courts in Gold Canyon the nearest public courts require a minimum of an hour round trip to access the nearest courts.
- 3. The project goals and objectives are to enhance education, health and economic & community development for the community of Gold Canyon by providing standard pickleball surfaced courts in order to meet the following objectives:
 - a. Provide standard Pickleball facilities in support of student and community pickleball education and recreational play.
 - b.Promote a healthier community in terms of physical and mental well-being as pickleball has grown tremendously given its effect of bringing generations and communities together in a way that promotes physical and mental well-being while engaging in a fun and challenging activity. The court surfacing will also result in a safer surface for playing pickleball thereby reducing the risk of injury.
 - c. Enhancing the amenities in our community by providing highly sought after standard pickleball courts which will make our growing community more attractive to new and existing residents thereby contributing to the overall economic and community development of our area.
- 4. The timetable for implementation of the Project will be as follows:
 - a) Final project prep including vendor selection and school coordination 2 months
 - b) Cement prep and acrylic surfacing 1 month
 - c) Surrounding rock placement 2 weeks
 - d) Net delivery and installation 2 weeks

B. Resources.

- 1. Identify current funding sources for the Project: A one-time funding request to complete this project is being made to Arizona Tribes as part of the Tribal/State Gaming Compact.
- 2. Identify other organizations or partners that are participating in or contributing to the Project, but which are not funding sources, and describe their roles or contributions.
 - a) The Apache Junction Unified School District is providing the land and foundational cement slab for this project.

- b) The Apache Junction Unified School District and Peralta Trails Elementary School will oversee the project.
- c) The Peralta Trails Pickleball Club will serve in a volunteer capacity for project management and day to day project oversight and reporting. This club has previously raised funds in order to provide fencing around the proposed pickleball court area this fencing project is now complete.
- d) Pinal County will serve as the financial intermediary.
- e) Licensed vendors will be contracted to execute the specialized tasks needed to complete the project.
- 3. Define the Project as a new or continuing project or a purchase. Provide information about how the Project will be sustained or the purchase will be maintained after the grant funding is exhausted.
 - a) The court surfacing project is a new project.
 - b) The court surfacing is expected to have a minimum court life of 5 years. The life of the court would be extended by the included landscaping work to prevent rocks and debris being blown onto the court and scratching the surface. The Peralta Trails Pickleball club will provide volunteer resources to sweep or blow water and debris from the courts on a regular basis in order to keep them maintained for school and community use. If the court needs repair in the future, the school would seek grants or donations from the community to fund the repairs.
