A. Purpose of Grant.

1. Project: Play Area Shade Improvements

Mammoth-San Manuel Unified School District (MSMUSD) would like to secure funding to enhance the physical environment of our campus by increasing the number of shaded areas. Our goal is to promote the health and wellness of students by improving access to outdoor spaces, which serve as important areas for congregation, relaxation, play, and educational activities. MSMUSD currently needs shade structures above playground areas and open spaces to increase the amount of time students spend in healthful outdoor activities.

Research indicates that exposure to natural environments contributes positively to mental health, social connections, and overall wellness. However, during the warmer months, the lack of shade can deter students from utilizing outdoor spaces, leading to decreased physical activity and social interaction. By providing more shaded areas, we can encourage students to spend more time outdoors, fostering a sense of community and enhancing their overall well-being.

Health promotion: Outdoor spaces play a crucial role in promoting physical activity among students. By providing shaded areas, we encourage students to engage in outdoor activities, which are vital for maintaining a healthy lifestyle. Additionally, shade covers will reduce exposure to harmful UV rays, thereby lowering the risk of skin cancer and heat-related illnesses. This aligns with health promotion objectives aimed at educating students about safe outdoor practices.

Wellness and Recreational Activities: The shaded areas can be utilized for various wellness programs, including physical education classes, team sports, informal play, outdoor spaces for educational projects, and recreational activities. These programs not only promote fitness but also foster teamwork and social interactions, essential for holistic student development. The installation of shade covers will enhance the usability of outdoor areas throughout the year, encouraging students to participate in recreational activities regardless of the weather. This can include organized sports, informal play, class activities, and community events. Engaging in recreational activities has been linked to improved student morale and academic performance, further emphasizing the importance of providing conducive environments for such activities.

Promoting Fitness and Educational Achievement: With increased shaded areas, students are more likely to participate in physical activities like running, playing ball games, or even group exercises. This directly supports our goals to enhance physical fitness levels in students. Active students are typically healthier and experience better concentration in academic settings, contributing positively to their overall educational experience.

Mental and Behavioral Health: Access to shaded outdoor areas can greatly benefit students' mental health by providing relaxing environments that promote positive mood and social interactions. Research indicates that outdoor activities can contribute to reduced anxiety and depression among youth. By fostering an environment conducive to both physical and mental wellness, we address behavioral health concerns and initiatives to support students' overall emotional well-being.

Ak-Chin Indian Community 2025 Prop 202 – 12% Contribution Grant Application Outline for Narrative

The proposed installation of 4 shade covers at Mammoth-San Manuel Unified School District campuses is an essential step towards fulfilling our commitment to promoting health, wellness, and fitness activities for students. This project will create a safe, engaging, and supportive outdoor environment that enhances both the physical and mental health of our students. We believe that this funding will significantly contribute to the overall well-being of our school community.

- 2. MSMUSD currently serves approximately 540 students preK-12. It is anticipated that all students will have access to 1 or more of the shade structures. Our students are our targeted population. Our student population resides in the tri-community area of Mammoth, San Manuel, and Oracle Arizona.
- 3. The objectives of the Play Area Shade Improvements Project are:
 - Increase shaded areas on campus to provide comfortable environments for students to gather, study, and engage in recreational activities.
 - Promote physical and social activity by encouraging the use of outdoor areas for exercise, group activities, educational projects, and events.

Plan to meet goals:

- Shade structures completed by end of school year 2026
- Establish revised activity/recess time for all grades to utilize the shaded areas July 2026
- Monitor activity/recess time throughout the 2025-2026 school year to gauge the utilization of the areas since installation of shade structures.
- 4. Plan for implementation of the Play Area Shade Improvements Project:
 - January 2026 funds to be awarded
 - March 2026 begins construction of shade structures
 - Construction estimated end date June 2026 (if there are delays with ordering parts or permits, MSMUSD will begin construction July 2026 to be completed by December 2026)

B. Resources.

- 1. MSMUSD does not have a current funding source to complete the Play Area Shade Improvements Project.
- 2. American Dermatological Association provides sun safe curriculum for our elementary and preschool classes.
- 3. The Play Area Shade Improvements Project is a new project.

 Maintaining the shade structures once they are installed would be undertaken through our operations budget. After the initial 10-year warranty for the shade structures, we would fund maintenance of the structures through our annual operational budget.
- 4. MSMUSD has no pending requests for the Play Area Shade Improvements Project for the past 18 months. MSMUSD has no funded requests within the past 5 years from any tribal community.

C. Reporting & Accountability

- 1. iVisions (accounting system through the county education superintendent's office) will be used to be in compliance with state of Arizona's accounting manual (i.e. quotes, requisitions, SAM registration, inventory, and funds management). Person responsible: Amy Stump, Grant Coordinator.
