St. Peter Indian Mission Catholic School Grant Proposal

Purpose of the Grant

St. Peter Indian Mission School strives to educate the whole child: mind, body and spirit. Situated in Bapchule, St Peter's has been serving the Gila River Indian Community for over 100 years and is a safe haven for students. The school has been run by the Franciscan Sisters of Christian Charity for 90 years and is also overseen by the Franciscan Friars of the Holy Spirit who teach, lead the youth group, and provide opportunities to receive the sacraments.

St. Peter's believes that the fundamental O'odham Himdag of respect, reverence, and responsibility, and the Gospel message of God's faithful, forgiving love, provide a stable, challenging, and academic environment that will foster self-discipline, academic success, cultural pride, strong faith in God, loyalty to country, service to community, and fitness for life.

High school is a pivotal time for students, where the choices they make affect the rest of their lives. There's a need for high school students on the Gila River Reservation to be supported in all areas of their lives, setting them up for success whether they choose to stay on the reservation, go to college, or obtain a job off reservation.

St. Peter's is currently the only high school on the reservation. Since the 2023 school year, a grade has been added each year, until there will be a full high school by 2027. In the midst of building out a robust high school that incorporates academic courses and trade programs, there is a need to build out extracurricular activities for the students, one of them being a sports program to provide students with leadership skills, responsibility, healthy lifestyle choices, healthy coping skills and more.

Before St. Peter High School, students attended schools off reservation, most of them dropping out because of bullying and being at schools that didn't take their culture into account. Over 60% of adults living on the Gila River Indian Reservation have not completed high school. Now that there is a high school on the reservation, it's essential to build out all the programs in order to give students a high school experience that will set them up for a hopeful future.

A sports program that promotes fitness for life is essential on a reservation where obesity and diabetes are struggles of the people. According to Jovana Brown in, *When Our Water Returns: Gila River Indian Community and Diabetes*, "American Indian youths have the highest prevalence of Type 2 diabetes. In the 15-19 age group the current figures are: 4.5 per 1000 for all U.S. American Indian populations. 50.9 per 1000 for Pima Indians."

From the national library of medicine: in 2010, the Centers for Disease Control reported a positive correlation between students who participated in high levels of physical activity and improved academic achievement, decreased risk of heart disease and diabetes, improved weight control, and less psychological dysfunction. Conversely, children who are obese often experience a diminished quality of life, learning difficulties, and decreased self-confidence.

St. Peter's strives to equip students so they can continue healthy lifestyles after graduating and pass on health to their children and families. Sports would provide students with that fitness education, and would set them up for success in this area, providing them with skills to combat diabetes and other health-related issues.

Diabetes isn't the main struggle of the youth on the reservation. Most students come from non-nuclear families where addiction is prevalent. Gang violence and suicide are also common struggles that students face. The Sisters and Friars who work at the school have found that nearly all of the students have endured some amount of trauma in their lives.

Principal of the grade school, Sr. Martha Mary Carpenter talked about these struggles in a presentation she gave at a fundraiser in 2023. She explained that during the height of COVID, there were 72 funerals held at St. Peter Indian Mission, in one week there were 5 funerals alone. Of those 72 funerals, 9 were COVID-related deaths, and the rest were due to gang violence, suicide, serosis and other addictive behaviors. Of the 72 funerals, 27 were former students of St. Peter's, and the youngest was 24 years old. With sorrow in her voice, Sr. Martha talked about her youngest former student who passed away during this time, "I could just see him sitting in his desk."

At St. Peter Indian Mission, the Sisters and Friars are on a mission to meet students in their suffering and introduce them to Jesus who wants to be with them in their suffering. High school student, Mariya, has felt the loving community surrounding her during difficult times, "Here it feels like I'm part of a family, people actually care about the students here. Me, losing my mother, that was the teachers I had for support."

Sports programs would be another avenue for students to heal from these traumatic experiences and give hope to students who oftentimes feel hopeless. Studies show that sports programs help students cope with difficult situations and have resilience to handle difficult situations in the future. The presidents council on sports found that participating in sports is associated with lower rates of anxiety and depression, higher self-esteem and confidence, reduced risk of suicide, and less substance abuse and fewer risky behaviors.

Right now, St. Peter's cannot afford a sports program because certified drivers are being paid overtime to do the morning and afternoon bus rounds each week. Part of the building of the high school will include the building of a school gym which will be the first step in creating a sport's program for students.

St. Peter's is working to obtain three mini buses. Three more mini buses, in addition to the three that St. Peter's already owns, would allow for some of the evening maintenance staff to drive students home after practice. This would save money since St. Peter's would no longer be paying certified drivers overtime hours.

In addition, St. Peter's is in need of an outdoor multipurpose turf field that will be used for football, soccer and other sports as the program takes shape. The field will be 58,000 square feet and will be the perfect place for practice as well as a place where St. Peter's could host sporting events in the future. Building a turf field will be a visible sign to students that the school is taking big steps to add a sports program and will give students a sense of joy, seeing the great lengths the school is going to provide for them.

Target Population

Sr. Martha Mary, principal of the grade school explained who is impacted by St. Peter's in an interview with CBS in 2016, "We don't teach subjects. We teach children."

The Sisters and Friars who run the school are dedicated to educating the students. In particular, the high school students on the Gila River Reservation will benefit from the sports program, who are in need of support during this pivotal time in their lives. In the midst of this pivotal time, most students at St. Peter's are living in unstable living situations.

Only 24.1% of households on Gila River are occupied by a married couple while 23.1% are male households and 45.3% are female households. Growing up without a mother and father greatly affects the students at St. Peter's, adding to their lack of stability and security. Students

find a sense of family at St. Peter's that is oftentimes lacking in their home lives. The school gives them a sense of family and home, which they will find even further on sports teams.

Students find a fatherly love in the Friars and motherly love in the Sisters, who genuinely care for their wellbeing. It's providing that loving environment at St. Peter's that helps students to thrive. At St. Peter's, the students are steeped in a loving environment that they can depend on, day after day, and when the days get rough, it's the Sisters and Friars who are there to support them and be with them in deep moments of suffering.

There are stories after stories of students, alumni, guardians, and community members who found a home at St. Peter's.

One story is Mariya. She comes from a long line of family members who have attended St. Peter's. She has attended the school since kindergarten and is part of the first high school class, who are now sophomores. She has eight siblings and helps to take care of her four younger siblings with her grandparents. Growing up, she didn't believe in God. But after being steeped in scripture and learning about God from attending St. Peter's, she now has a strong faith and says that the faith hasn't just impacted her, it's impacted her whole family. "If we didn't have God in the home, I probably wouldn't be where I am today," Mariya said.

Unfortunately, Mariya is similar to many of her classmates who don't grow up in a nuclear household. Her dad hasn't been in the picture for years and her mom passed away during her freshman year. During that tumultuous time, she expressed that it was the Sisters and Friars who she had for support that got her through. "Sometimes it gets too overwhelming for me to handle, as it does for everybody. You can only hold so much stress and then eventually pop. I've experienced that. [The Sisters and Friars] were a good support system for me. I was able to tell them... what I was going through and what I needed to get off my chest and they were always there to help me. I would tell them about my family and sometimes I would be like, I don't know what to do, I don't know who to turn to anymore. And they were always there for me to turn to. I've told my siblings too, 'If you need anything go to the Sisters, go to the Friars. They've helped me through a lot and I'm sure they'll be able to help you too.' Without the school, without church, without my grandparents, let's just say I'd be at a low place. I wouldn't be able to do what I'm doing now."

Mariya is just one example of the impact of St. Peter's. There is a hope for that impact to expand so that students will have a firm grasp on their health and wellness through the participation of the sports program, while also being another avenue of support during difficult times, helping students to cope with traumatic situations in their lives.

Students need this stability, consistency and love in their tumultuous high school years, which is often a pivotal time for students. It's for these reasons, among many other reasons, why the students of the Gila River Reservation are the target of this project.

The overall goal is to provide students with sports that they can participate in, in order to form well-rounded students, and not to mention all of the benefits of sports discussed earlier in this proposal. More specifically, St. Peter's has a goal of starting on the turf field by summer of 2026 and completing the field by the end of summer of 2027, ready for the 2027-2028 school year. By that academic year, there is also a goal of having at least two sports offered. In order to meet that goal, the first stage in implementing the sports program will have to be met, with the goal of completing that first stage in the 2025-2026 school year. This entails purchasing three mini buses. Three more mini buses, in addition to the three that St. Peter's already owns, would allow for some of the evening maintenance staff to drive students home after practice. This would save money since St. Peter's would no longer be paying certified drivers overtime hours.

Resources

There have been other requests for funding for St. Peter Indian Mission High School which would also include the building of the gym which will support the sports program. Here is a breakdown of requests that have been made for the high school.

This is the second request that is solely for the sports program. The first request was also a Proposition 202 Grant Proposal to the Tohono O'odham Nation.

Other organizations that are supporting the project, but are not funding sources, are the Franciscan Friars of the Holy Spirit who are working alongside the Franciscan Sisters of Christian Charity to get this sports program off the ground. The Roman Catholic Diocese of Phoenix is another big support, as St. Peter's is one of the Catholic schools in the Diocese. The Diocese has provided monetary contributions to the school but not the sports program as of now. Regardless, the diocese is a support emotionally and spiritually. Another organization who has supported the promotion of physical activity at St. Peter's is the Arizona Cardinals, who have come out for Youth Training Camp.

The sports program is a new project, under the umbrella of the existing project of the building of the high school. After the grant funding is exhausted, the project will be sustained by donors of St. Peter Indian Mission as well as by the various connections with organizations and individuals that the Franciscan Sisters of Christian Charity know personally.

When it comes down to it, the Franciscan Sisters have learned to put all of their requests in the hands of God. Sr. Martha Mary Carpenter often expresses the need to trust in Jesus and His timing. That being said, the project will be sustained by the Lord, on His timing, as have all the other projects at St. Peter Indian Mission Catholic School.

In a story with *The Catholic Sun* Newspaper, principal of the high school, Sr. Pamela Peasel said, "I tell people now, I'm not leading this school, Sister Martha isn't leading this school, God is completely leading us and we're just following His guidance in all of this with all of the trials we have faced. We know beyond a doubt that the Lord wants this to happen and we're just continuing to listen and move forward with everything."

Another request was made for the purchasing of three mini buses, as mentioned above. The request was made for \$250,000 from the Tohono O'odham Nation's Proposition 202 grant for 2025.

St. Peter's has received funding from the Gila River Reservation the past five years which has been used to support student's tuition and activities. The amount for each year has been around \$198,675.

If funding is received, St. Peter's will account for and manage funding in an organized manner, in a way that stewards the money responsibly. An excel document will be kept of all expenditures associated with the building of the turf field. Costs will be compared before settling on turf that is cost effective while also choosing quality turf that can withstand many years of use. If funds were to be received, the excel document along with other pertinent documents will be sent to Ak-Chin Indian Community. St. Peter's desires to remain transparent and honest during the building of the field so as to model what the school desires for students to become: respectful, reverent and responsible citizens.

Progress will be tracked and documented by taking periodic pictures throughout the process as well as keeping a timeline of what has to get done in order to see the project to its completion. The timeline will be followed and progress will be shown as each step gets St. Peter's closer to the completion of the project.

This responds to your August 1, 2023, request for information regarding the status of your group tax exemption.

Our records indicate that you were issued a determination letter in March 1946, that you are currently exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, and are not a private foundation within the meaning of section 509(a) of the Code because you are described in sections 509(a)(1) and 170(b)(1)(A)(i).

With your request, you provided a copy of the *Official Catholic Directory for 2023*, which includes the names and addresses of the agencies and instrumentalities and the educational, charitable, and religious institutions operated by the Roman Catholic Church in the United States, its territories, and possessions that are subordinate organizations under your group tax exemption. Your request indicated that each subordinate organization is a non-profit organization, that no part of the net earnings thereof inures to the benefit of any individual, and that no substantial part of their activities is for promotion of legislation. You have further represented that none of your subordinate organizations is a private foundation under section 509(a), although all subordinates do not all share the same sub-classification under section 509(a). Based on your representations, the subordinate organizations in the *Official Catholic Directory for 2023* are recognized as exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the Code under GEN 0928.

Donors may deduct contributions to you and your subordinate organizations as provided in section 170 of the Code. Bequests, legacies, devises, transfers, or gifts to them or for their use are deductible for federal estate and gifts tax purposes if they meet the applicable provisions of section 2055, 2106, and 2522 of the Code.

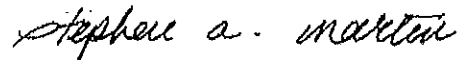

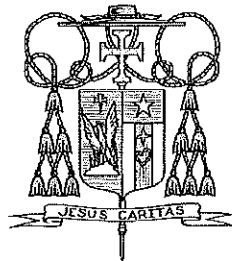
