A RESOLUTION OF THE PINAL COUNTY, ARIZONA, BOARD OF SUPERVISORS RELEASING THE TEN PERCENT GUARANTEE BOND (MAINTENANCE BOND NO. 016213701) IN CONNECTION WITH THE VILLAGE AT COPPER BASIN UNIT 5C-2, LOCATED IN SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 3 SOUTH, RANGE 8 EAST, SUPERVISOR DISTRICT 4.

WHEREAS, this matter has been brought before the Pinal County Board of Supervisors (the “**Board**”) by a request from the subdivision developer (the “**Subdivider**”) in connection with The Village at Copper Basin Unit 5C-2 (the “**Subdivision**”); and,

WHEREAS, the Subdivider has previously completed construction of all required Subdivision improvements, which were accepted by the Board on or about June 19, 2024 by way of Resolution No. 061924-RD23-176, recorded on June 19, 2024 at Fee Number 2024-046236 (the “**Improvements**”); and,

WHEREAS, the Subdivider posted a ten percent guarantee bond, which, per Pinal County Development Services Code (“**PCDSC**” or the “**Code**”) § 3.40.040(C)(4), is to guarantee against damage by on-site construction for a period of one year after acceptance of the Improvements by the Board; and,

WHEREAS, per the terms of the ten percent guarantee bond, the same guarantees that the Improvements shall be free from defects of workmanship and materials, general wear and tear excepted, for a period of 1 year from the date of acceptance of the Improvements; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to PCDSC § 3.40.040(C)(4), “[a]fter completion of one year, satisfactory correction of any damages, and upon inspection by the county engineer, the ten percent guarantee bond may be released”; and,

WHEREAS, the ten percent guarantee bond in this matter is identified as Maintenance Bond No. 016213701 in the amount of Ninety Three Thousand Four Hundred Eighty Six and 00/100 Dollars (\$93,486.00) issued by Liberty Mutual Insurance Company, a copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit “A”** (the “**Maintenance Bond**”); and,

WHEREAS, the Pinal County Department of Public Works and the county engineer have inspected the Improvements and have determined that they are in conformance with Pinal County standards and that all applicable Code requirements have been met such that the Maintenance Bond may be released.

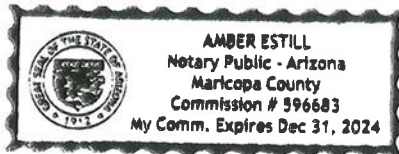

ARTICLE IV - OFFICERS: Section 12. Power of Attorney.

Any power or authority granted to any representative or attorney-in-fact under the provisions of this article may be revoked at any time by the Board, the Chairman, the President or by the officer or officers granting such power or authority.

ARTICLE XIII - Execution of Contracts: Section 5. Surety Bonds and Undertakings.

Any officer of the Company authorized for that purpose in writing by the chairman or the president, and subject to such limitations as the chairman or the president may prescribe, shall appoint such attorneys-in-fact, as may be necessary to act in behalf of the Company to make, execute, seal, acknowledge and deliver as surety any and all undertakings, bonds, recognizances and other surety obligations. Such attorneys-in-fact subject to the limitations set forth in their respective powers of attorney, shall have full power to bind the Company by their signature and execution of any such instruments and to attach thereto the seal of the Company. When so executed such instruments shall be as binding as if signed by the president and attested by the secretary.

Certificate of Designation - The President of the Company, acting pursuant to the Bylaws of the Company, authorizes David M. Carey, Assistant Secretary to appoint such attorneys-in-fact as may be necessary to act on behalf of the Company to make, execute, seal, acknowledge and deliver as surety any and all undertakings, bonds, recognizances and other surety obligations.

Authorization - By unanimous consent of the Company's Board of Directors, the Company consents that facsimile or mechanically reproduced signature of any assistant secretary of the Company, wherever appearing upon a certified copy of any power of attorney issued by the Company in connection with surety bonds, shall be valid and binding upon the Company with the same force and effect as though manually affixed.
