FIRST AMENDMENT TO INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN PINAL COUNTY AND THE CITY OF APACHE JUNCTION DEFINING RESPONSIBILITY FOR ROAD MAINTENANCE OF SUPERSTITION MOUNTAIN DRIVE, SOUTH MOUNTAIN VIEW ROAD, AND SOUTHERN AVENUE

THIS INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT ("Agreement") dated the _____day of ______, 2020, is made by and between PINAL COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Arizona ("Pinal") and CITY OF APACHE JUNCTION, an Arizona municipal corporation ("Apache Junction"), both collectively referred to as the "Parties" or individually as a "Party".

RECITALS

- A) County and Apache Junction are Parties to the "Intergovernmental Agreement Defining Responsibility for Road Maintenance of Superstition Mountain Drive, South Mountain View Road and Southern Avenue" dated February 28, 2018 (the "Agreement").
- B) The Parties desire to amend the Agreement by including North Mountain View Road and Jacob Waltz Street.

AGREEMENT

- 1. All provisions of the Agreement are hereby incorporated by this reference into this First Amendment. The provisions of the Agreement shall continue in full force and effect except as specifically amended by this First Amendment.
- 2. Section 1 of the Agreement shall be revised to read as follows:

For public safety and welfare of the public, the Parties hereto agree to maintain portions of paved and unpaved roadways known as:

Exhibit A – Superstition Mountain Drive – US 60 to approximately 300' north Exhibit B – Mountain View Road – US 60 to 32nd Avenue Exhibit C – Southern Avenue – Delaware Drive to Ironwood Drive Exhibit D – Southern Avenue – Mariposa Road to Tomahawk Road Tomahawk Road – US 60 to approximately 615' north Exhibit E – Jacob Waltz Street – Mountain View Road to Nodak Road Mountain View Road – Tepee Street to Singletree Street

3. Section 4 of the Agreement shall be revised to read as follows:

Pinal County agrees to provide regular and routine roadway maintenance on the portions of the roadways depicted in Exhibits A, B, D (Tomahawk Road) and E lying within the City of Apache Junction jurisdiction. This includes:

Exhibit A – Superstition Mountain Drive – US 60 to approximately 300' north Exhibit B – Mountain View Road – US 60 to 32^{nd} Avenue

Exhibit D – Tomahawk Road – US 60 to approximately 615' north Exhibit E – Jacob Waltz Street – Mountain View Road to Nodak Road Mountain View Road – Tepee Street to Singletree Street

Furthermore, Pinal County agrees for those roads depicted in Exhibit E to provide the below:

- A. Peace officer patrols (including 911 calls)
- B. Noise complaints
- C. PM-10 air quality
- D. Illegal dumping within easement
- E. Indemnify the City as communicated in section six of the Agreement.
- 4. This Agreement may be cancelled for conflict of interest without further obligation penalty, in accordance with A.R.S. § 38-511.
