The Pinal County Attorney's Office requests approval of the FY2020 Arizona Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding Grant agreement, ACJC Grant Number ACESF-21-043 between the Arizona Criminal Justice Commission and Pinal County, through the Pinal County Attorney's Office, to commence on January 20, 2020 and terminate on January 20, 2022 in the amount of \$140,720.

The grant award will help to improve social distancing guidelines in limited office space, and using software/hardware to conduct Grand Jury presentations. The grant award does not require a match fund to be met by the Pinal County Attorney's Office. There is no impact to the General Fund.
