On July 1, 2020, The Pinal County Attorney's Office received approval from the Pinal County Board of Supervisors to accept the FY2020 Arizona Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding Grant agreement, ACJC Grant Number ACESF-21-043 between the Arizona Criminal Justice Commission and Pinal County, through the Pinal County Attorney's Office, to commence on January 20, 2020 and terminate on January 20, 2022 in the amount of \$140,720.

The Pinal County Attorney's Office requests approval to align the FY 19/20 award received for the Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding Program Award #ACESF-21-043 between the Arizona Criminal Justice Commission and the Pinal County Attorney's Office, through the Pinal County Board of Supervisors for the FY 20/21 budget. The funds will be used for equipment and supplies. The acceptance requires an amendment to the FY20/21 budget for \$49,441. A transfer of reserve appropriation only from Fund 213 (Grants/Project Contingency) to Fund 268 (Co Atty Misc Grants) to increase revenue and expenditure appropriations. There is no impact on the General Fund.
