Business Sustainability Program (Mortgage, Rent and Utilities and a 25% decrease in revenue)

Round 1:

Three month eligibility period with max of \$15,000 for qualifying expenses

Round 2:

Six Month eligibility period with max of \$30,000 for qualifying expenses

- First time applicants eligible for full six months/\$30,000
- Previous recipients eligible for additional three months/\$30,000 total when combined with first application





Round 3 Proposal

- Application Receipt Period: December 1, 2020 February 28, 2021
 - Cap of \$15,000 for qualifying businesses.
- Only applications received from first time applicants during the month of December will be processed.
 - **Qualified Expenses**: Any three (3) month period between March 1, 2020 and February 28, 2021
- Applications received during the months of January and February will be accepted on a first come/first served basis from any businesses including those who qualified during the first two rounds of the Program
 - **Qualified Expenses**: Any three (3) month period not previously funded (Not eligible for same three or six month period if previously funded between March 1, 2020 and February 28, 2021)
- Reduction of qualifying loss in revenue from 25% to 20%
- \$2m cap for entire program.
 - Balance remaining for Round 3 (after Round 1 and Round 2): \$750,903
