Program Year 2019 Data Validation

DES QAIA Data Validation Audit:

- Conducted October 2021
- Review included cases from the Adult, Dislocated Worker and Youth Programs
- > Types of errors found include lack of documentation of:
- Birthdate
- Start/completion/withdrew date from training
- Low income status at program entry

Cases Reviewed	10
Data Elements Reviewed	329
Cases with Errors Found	4
Accuracy Rate	98%



Policies ready for PCWDB Approval

Draft Monitoring Policy (Revision)

- Adds a monthly monitoring process as part of required monitoring the WIOA Title I-B Adult, Dislocated Worker and Youth Programs
- Posted for public comment between October 25, 2021-November 5, 2021
- Review session held November 10, 2021

Draft Grievance, Complaints, and Appeals Policy (Revision)

- Adds requirement for all ARIZONA@WORK Pinal County partners to submit/track all grievances, complaints, and appeals to the PCWDB
- Adds a requirement for all ARIZONA@WORK Pinal County partners to use a Google form to submit/track grievances, complaints and appeals
- Applies to all ARIZONA@WORK Pinal County partners that sign the Memorandum of Understanding
- Posted for public comment between November 29, 2021-December 10, 2021
- Review session held January 11, 2022
