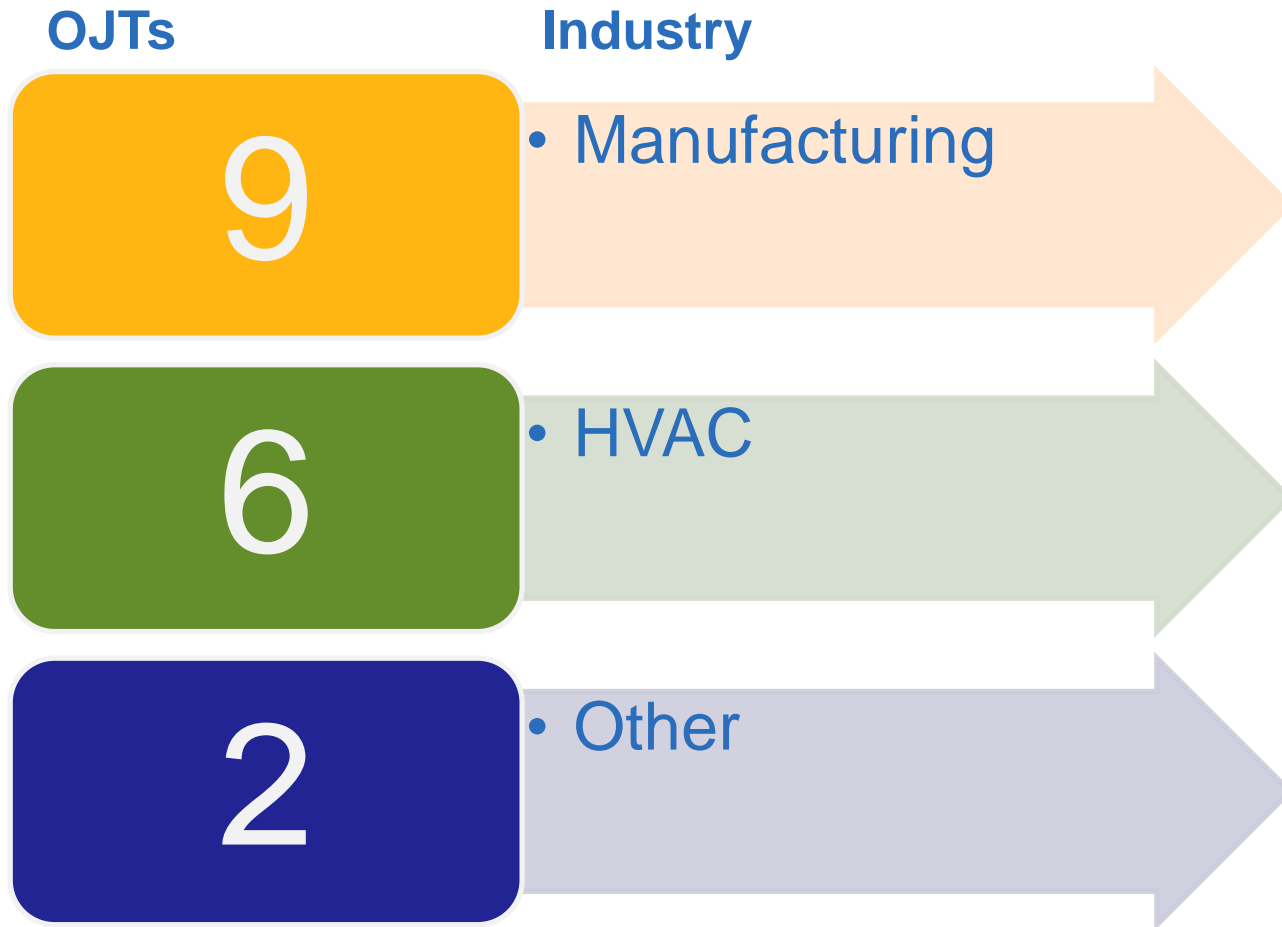


On-the-Job Trainings Mar-Apr

Success Stories



- Participant enrolled in our program during the Truck Yeah! Event. She completed training and started employment in April making \$24.50/hr.
- Justice involved participant who served time for armed robbery. Our team was able to leverage On-the-job training to connect this individual with a second chance opportunity. After successful completion of the OJT, he is earning almost \$19.00/hr. and his employer loves him.
