## **Pinal County Fill the Gap Projections for FY23**

Below is the fiscal year 2023 projection on Fill the Gap (FTG) available state funds.

As you are probably aware, revenue generated through FTG is distributed based on a three-year index of felony case filings and population. Based on this index and current revenue projections, the maximum amount of State funding available for which Pinal can apply is \$102,942.00, in addition to any unused portion of funding allocated to the county in FY 2022.

The FY 2023 projection is \$1,441.00 more than the amount of FY22 funds for Pinal County. Funding has been impacted primarily due to declining revenue and changes in county populations. Historically, the fund carried a fund balance to enable the AOC to handle revenue fluctuations from year to year; however, the Legislature swept the fund balance of \$100,000 in FY16, compounding the problem.
