

**RENEWAL ONE TO THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT
BETWEEN PINAL COUNTY AND YAVAPAI COUNTY
FOR SHARING OF TREASURER’S REMITTANCE AND ONLINE COLLECTION
SYSTEM**

This RENEWAL ONE TO THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT effective April 19, 2022, (“**Renewal One**”), is made by and between PINAL COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Arizona (“**Pinal County**”) and YAVAPAI COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Arizona (“**Yavapai County**”). Pinal County and Yavapai County are sometimes referred to herein individually as a “**Party**” and collectively as the “**Parties**”.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Pinal County and Yavapai County entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement dated April 19, 2017, (“**Agreement**”) for Yavapai County’s use of the TROCS System developed by Pinal County; and

WHEREAS, the Parties wish to exercise the option to renew the Agreement for an additional term of three (3) years; and

WHEREAS, the Parties have conferred regarding support costs set forth in Article 3 of the Agreement and desire those costs to continue as in the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Parties are authorized to enter into this Agreement pursuant to the provisions of Arizona Revised Statutes (“**A.R.S.**”) § 11-952.

AGREEMENT

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties hereto, in consideration of the stipulations, covenants and agreements hereinafter set forth, hereby agree as follows:

ARTICLE 1. RENEWAL ONE

The Parties hereby exercise Renewal One to the Agreement as set forth in Article 5 to the Agreement. The support costs set forth in Article 3 shall remain the same for the renewal term. All other provisions in the Agreement shall remain the same. The term of this renewal is three (3) years from the date it is fully executed.
