Pinal County Attorney's Office Project Proposal

Background:

The Pinal County Attorney's Investigations Bureau has eight full-time AZPOST sworn investigators, a computer forensic analyst, and a senior administrative assistant. Most investigators have an average of at least 25 years of law enforcement experience. The members of this bureau work with Pinal County prosecutors to enhance cases for prosecution and assist them in preparing cases for trial. In addition, the investigators in this unit use their experience and expertise to assist law enforcement agencies within Pinal County in the investigation of major crimes. During a typical investigator's day, they locate and interview witnesses, serve subpoenas, assist with documentation of crime scenes among other investigative duties. Our experienced investigator's assist law enforcement agencies within county with firearms and other essential training. In addition, these investigators also participate in presentations to demonstrate and educate the community about our role in the criminal justice system.

Problem Statement (A) & (B):

Pinal County is approximately 5,374 sq. miles and has a current estimated population of 510,738. Pinal County is diverse in its landscapes and population. Pinal County Attorney's Office Investigators find themselves in various areas of Pinal County as well as all other Counties within Arizona to interview witnesses or serve subpoenas. During these processes, there is potential to come in contact with defendants and/or suspects involved with the investigations, resulting in a potential officer safety situation. Some of these areas are remote and cell signal and radio signal can be nonexistent with our current radios. Furthermore, while commuting to various areas within Pinal County for duties, Pinal County Investigators listen to their radios and are in areas when incidents can and have occurred, which needed immediate responses. Investigators are also in these areas where Deputies/Officers are carrying out their duties, and if the immediate backup is needed Pinal County Investigators have and will respond to assist.

The Pinal County Attorney's Office would like to request funds to purchase the APX8000 dual band radio. The Pinal County Attorney's Office current APX 900's are what is considered a single band radio (800mhz only). By upgrading to the APX 8000 we will be getting a dual band radio which will allow us to communicate with other interoperability partners throughout the county/state that do not have 800mhz radios. In addition to that, our vehicles currently do not have trunked radio resources. Adding an APX 8500 mobile radio to the vehicle will cost roughly as much as the APX 8000. Going with the Vehicular adapter and upgrading to the APX 8000 will allow our agency to have better interoperability and will effectively act as a mobile radio in our vehicles.

Another safety benefit to upgrading current systems to these radios is that if for any reason our Trunked radio network were to fail (or even temporarily be shut down for routine maintenance) our Investigators would have no communication. Conversely if we were to aid another agency outside of the Pinal County radio network we would also have no communication (aside from 800mhz Mutual Aid). By having VHF as a secondary band we could switch over to a simplex asset and have point to point communication rather than no communication.

Based on this, the Pinal County Attorney's Office is requesting funds for the purchase of the APX8000 radio that would be suitable for the job function and consistent with the Pinal County Sheriff's Office whose radio system/repeaters we currently operate on. In addition to the radios, the PCAO is requesting the installation and mounts which give these radios the capability to be a car mounted radio as well as a hand held radio with the push of a button.

There are various benefits to using these radios and the requested mounting system. The radios themselves allow for the investigator to hear and communicate better with the Pinal County Sheriff's Office dispatch as well and Deputies/Officers from various agencies within and out of Pinal County. The use of this mounting option improves Officer Safety by allowing the investigator to remove the radio to carry it when making contact at unknown residences with unknown occupants.

This system also allows for the easy removal and reinstallation if a vehicle is removed from service due to mileage or becomes inoperable.
