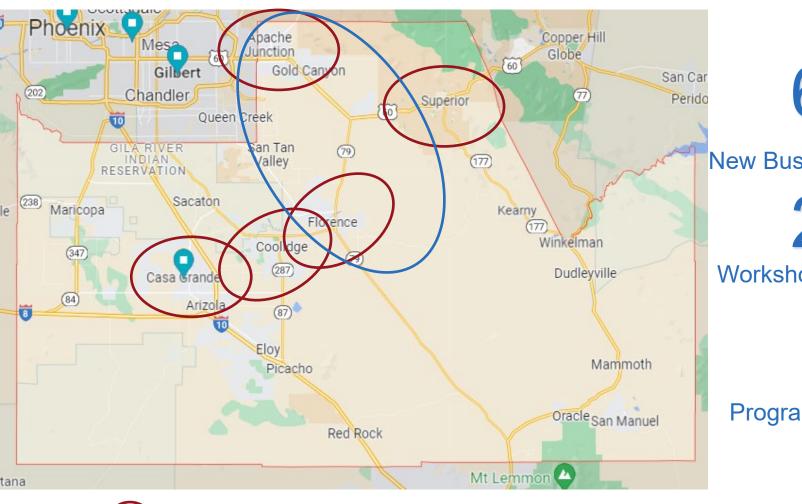

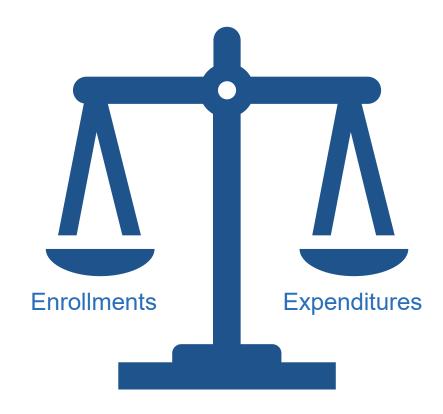

## For PY22 sustainability...

Request to transfer \$75,102 from Dislocated worker funding to Adult funding

60/40 Operational to Participant breakdown requirement as per contract:

- \$45,061 Operational Spending
- \$30,041 Participant Spending
- Summary of request: Based on reduced funding and rising costs of training programs, participant budgets are tight when compared to enrollment goals.
  Team is also looking to bring on additional member to alleviate workloads.
  - Second transfer may be requested depending on enrollment paces of Adult and Dislocated Worker participants.
