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## **RESOLUTION NO.**

## A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PINAL COUNTY CANCELLING THE REGULAR ELECTION OF NOVEMBER 8, 2022 FOR CERTAIN POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS IN PINAL COUNTY.

**WHEREAS,** Pinal County is a regularly constituted and organized County within the State of Arizona; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to A.R.S. § 16-410(A), in any election that is to be held pursuant to title 15 or title 48 of the Arizona Revised Statutes, if the total of the number of persons who file a nomination petition for a candidate and the number of persons who file a nomination paper for a write-in candidate is less than or equal to the number of positions to be filled at the election for which the nomination petition or nomination paper is filed, the county board of supervisors may cancel the election and appoint the person or persons who filed the nomination petition or nomination paper to fill the position for the term of office for which the candidate was nominated; and

**WHEREAS**, the following listed is an election to be held pursuant to 48 of the Arizona Revised Statutes, for regularly constituted and organized political subdivisions within the State of Arizona and Pinal County; and

**WHEREAS**, for the following listed election the following persons have filed a nominating petition for election to the governing board of that particular political subdivision:

Bryan M. Hartman (Division 1 Director/3 year term) Siebe Hamstra (Divison 2 Director /3 year term) Tony Dugan (Division 3 Director /3 year term)

and are the only persons to have done so, thus rendering each election an uncontested election; and

**WHEREAS**, cancellation of said elections would result in substantial savings for the taxpayers of Pinal County by avoiding the numerous costs associated with conducting an election for the position of governing board member in these listed political subdivisions;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the County of Pinal as follows: 1. The elections for the positions of governing board member, scheduled for November 8, 2022 are canceled pursuant to the authority granted the Pinal County Board of Supervisors. 2. The persons listed above are hereby appointed to fill the position of governing board member for the terms indicated in the respective political subdivisions in Pinal County.

3. If no nomination petitions for a candidate and no nomination papers for a write-in candidate have been filed to fill the position for which the election was being held, the position is deemed vacant and shall be filled in accordance with laws governing the filling of those vacancies.

4. This action is taken pursuant to the authority granted the Pinal County Board of Supervisors under A.R.S. § 16-410(A).
