MWR - Prospective current funding sources for 2023-2024 will be from the Bert W. Martin Foundation, Pinal County Sheriff's Office employees, and local fundraisers. County funding is not used for this program, MWR has historically received funding through the Bert W. Martin Foundation.

CRU--None, currently there is no funding source for the Community Relations Unit - Shop w/the Sheriff annual event is generally funded by donations received throughout the year from local residents and our business community of Pinal County. Sources are prospective and donations fluctuate each year. CRU received funding from Bert W. Martin to fund the Shop w/the Sheriff 2023 holiday season.
